- \*June was a great month for circulation numbers!
  - 450 craft kits were distributed, with a different craft every week as part of Summer Reading Program.
  - Hoopla checkouts set a record high.
  - The wireless count topped May's extremely high usage.
  - June Young Adult circulation was the highest of the fiscal year. Adult and Juvenile also had great numbers last month.
  - DVDs, Launch Pads, pickleball sets, and bike equipment circulation also increased.
- \*The Gift Account balance is \$121,596.26.

There was no input from the public at the meeting.

- \*The board reviewed the Teen Room Policy and approved the policy with the changes as presented. (Lehtola/Weeks)
- \*For board training, the board discussed a history of US Libraries as provided by Erin.
